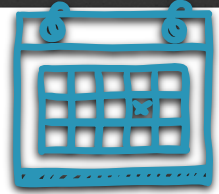

WHEN?

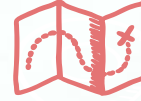


- GHP will be held June 12, 2022 – July 9, 2022
- Students attend classes in the mornings and afternoons in specific areas of study, and they participate in a wide variety of social and instructional opportunities every evening.

Required and expected costs to the students being

- dorm rooms necessities
- spending money as desired during the program.



QUALIFICATIONS

- + Be a current sophomore or junior
- + Receive a nomination/recommendation from a subject area teacher
- + Have demonstrated high aptitude and high interest in the area of nomination
- + Commit to the application, interview, and selection process
- + Commit to participation in the entire program



QUALITIES OF A GHP STUDENT

The ideal GHP student is...

- + Passionate about their area of study
- + Inquisitive
- + Ready to think and learn rapidly
- + Capable of interacting respectfully, cooperatively, and appropriately with their peers, instructors, and others
- + Exhibit the social and emotional maturity necessary to function in intensive classroom and residential settings

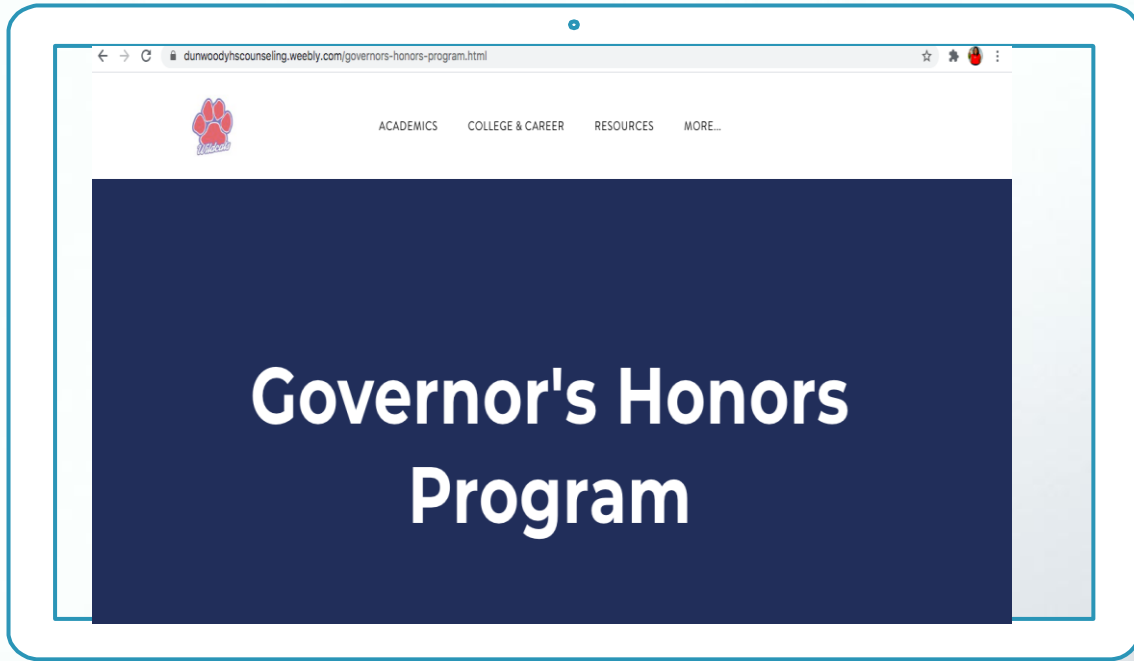
