

Important Announcements Yearbook

- Formal senior portraits must be taken by November 15. Formal portraits can be taken at any of the Cady Studios locations or at DHS on October 10. To schedule a photo session, visit CADY.COM, click "Seniors" at the top, and select "Schedule My Photos." Follow the prompts from there; the cheapest package is \$29. (Casual photos don't have to be taken by Cady.)
- If you've already taken your portraits, be sure to log in to your account at **CADY.COM** and select which formal and casual photo you want to be published in the yearbook. If you do not select photos yourself, they will be chosen for you.

Dunwoody High School **Dual Enrollment**

- Students must check Gafutures for a list of available courses for Dual Enrollment funding.
- Students must apply to the university they plan to attend, including sending applicable test scores.
- Students must request an Official Transcript through the link on the Counseling Weebly, be sent to GSU <u>AFTER</u> they have submitted their application. Requesting the transcript before the application is received by the college will result in a delay in matching the transcript with the student file.
- Students and parents must complete the funding application through Gafutures.
- DHS counselors DO NOT submit college applications for students.
- Students must complete and submit several forms for funding- forms were available at the Dual Enrollment Information Sessions in August.
 - These forms are REQUIRED to be uploaded to Infinite Campus for Dual Enrollment funding to be approved by Mr. Ingram.
 - Mr. Ingram can only approve funding for SPECIFIC courses that align with your graduation plan. We must have this list and check it against your graduation plan before we can approve funding. Unapproved courses will be dropped by the college.

DHS has no access to or authority over college systems. Please review college websites for updates regularly, and check email for communication from your college.

GSU Dual enrollment will have an informational session 9/14 in the Auditorium Lobby. Students must have a permission form on file and must receive a pass to attend.

Mr. Ingram will have a Dual Enrollment Makeup Session on 9/20 for interested students during the ROAR.



The DHS Counseling Department will be working with students and parents to utilize Naviance, a comprehensive website that students can use to make plans about colleges and careers.

Naviance Student will allow students to:


- •Get involved in the planning and advising process
 - complete online surveys, and manage timelines and deadlines for making decisions about colleges and careers
- Research colleges
 - Compare GPA, standardized test scores, and other statistics to actual historical data from our school for students who have applied and been admitted in the past
- Research careers
 - Research hundreds of careers and career clusters, and take career assessments
- •Create future plans
 - Create goals and to-dos, and complete tasks assigned by DCSD to better prepare your student for future college and career goals.

Please ensure that you select the correct application deadline in Naviance. Ex: If you are applying to UGA EA, the deadline should be Oct 15, not Jan 1.

Transcripts

- GAfutures: Students who had their Social Security Number on file on file by June can request their transcripts be sent to in-state colleges and universities.
- Naviance: Most transcripts, including those for Common App
- Mail: If your college needs a physical transcript, please bring a selfaddressed, stamped envelope. We will provide a sealed, official transcript.
- Alumni: Students who complete their Naviance tasks retain access to Naviance after graduation. Other requests may be made through the district website: dekalbschoolsga.org/records-and-transcripts/
